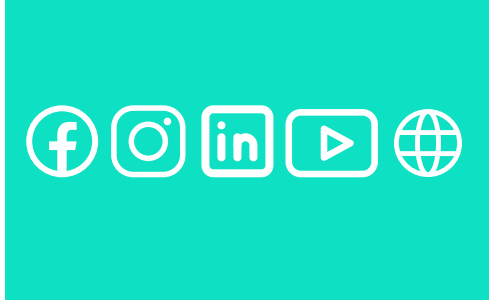
KoM – Covilhã, Portugal
